

REMINDERS

Our 2022 Focus: Curb Appeal

Together, lets keep our neighborhood in tip top shape! It is important to remember that maintaining our neighborhood curb appeal requires routine maintenance. Please be mindful of maintaining weeds, grass, bare spots, flower beds, mailboxes, shrubs, trees, appearance of your home (paint, pressure washing, and repairs). Avoid blowing grass clippings into the streets, sidewalks and curbs. Keep up the curb appeal by removing trash, debris, pine straw and leaves not only from your yard but also from our curbs and sidewalks. Your hard work won't go unnoticed! Yard of the month starts in April and goes through September. Winners will receive a Home Depot gift card and the honor of displaying the official St. Andrews at Rockport Yard of the Month lawn-sign.

*Please Note: Sentry will be much more vigilant in their drives through the neighborhood. The aforementioned violations will be noted.

Architectural Modifications

Want to paint your house? Add a shed in the backyard that is taller than the fence line? Remove trees and/or shrubs?

It's that time of year when we start thinking about exterior home improvement projects. When considering making changes to your home or property, please take the time to read the ARC Guidelines and refresh your understanding of the purpose of the ARC. These documents are available on www.hoabutler.com and www.standrewsrockport.com. Review and approval is required before any exterior change can be made. Examples of work needing approval are structural additions, remodeling, fencing (includes changing the height to the fence or fence stain (color), pools, sheds, trampolines, playsets, landscaping, using a different color roof shingle, tree / shrub removal and painting of a different color on shutters, house trim or doors. This is not an all inclusive list. The more details you can provide about your intentions and plans reduces the need for clarification questions and reduces the time needed for review and approval.

YARD MAINTENANCE

- All Lawns should be kept mowed, edged, and trimmed during growing seasons (Late March through early October).
- Lawns should be free of weeds yearround & may require mowing and/or treatments during the winter months.
- Planting beds should be kept free of grass & weeds; should have all plants or shrubs kept in a neat appearance; and fresh ground cover (straw, mulch, rocks as permitted) applied in the spring and fall.
- Shrubs should be trimmed/pruned in the spring and fall, and as needed to promote healthy growth and maintain a uniform appearance.
- Landscape or gardening supplies such as potting soil, fertilizer, and tools should be stored out of sight from the street in front of the residence, except when being actively used.
- Dead trees and shrubs may be removed to protect against property damage.

HOME MAINTENANCE

- Doors, shutters, and trim should be in good repair, and paint or stain kept in good order.
- All siding and exterior surfaces should be in good repair and kept free of mold, mildew, or other substances that can discolor and stain the house exterior.
- Roof, gutters, and flashing should be in good repair and all paint or stain kept in good order.
- Driveways should be kept clean, especially of oil stains.

- Mailboxes and posts should be in good repair, and paint kept in good order.
- Blinds and window treatments should be in good condition.
- All structures such as fences, sheds, and play equipment should be in good repair.

Please note any changes to the existing color(s) must be submitted to the ACC before proceeding.

FENCE MAINTENANCE

- Fences that are decaying and turning colors can be pressure washed and re-stained. The fence must remain a natural color and any painting will require an ACC request.
